- Discussion about the new E-Ray at events. How the E-Ray will fit with NCCC insurance?
- People Choice car show voting or judging needs to be clearly stated on the flier due to a protest over voting in Ohio
- Presently, during a Funkhana event you must use a helmet in the car. Rene is proposing to drop helmet use if car speeds are under 10 mph.
- Funkhanas are in the low-speed group matrix of events and Rene is requesting that it be moved into the rally group matrix of events and be scored the same as the rally format
- August 18 and 19 there will be a very special Corvette 70th Anniversary Exhibit at the M1 Concourse. They have reached out to NCCC membership for applicants to submit a photo and brief description of their Corvettes.
