- Awards have been ordered for the banquet
- Banquet awards budget tracking is approximately \$200 under budget

Webmaster – Gloria Reiffer

- The Michigan Region Apparel page has been updated. The new “store” link is live; members may need to refresh their browsers to see the latest content.
- Apparel options now include short and long sleeve shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters jackets, totes and more. Additional name personalization is available for \$4. Hats were not included due to an added logo-setup fee. Pickup or flat-rate delivery options are available.
- Appreciation expressed to members who notify when sanctions are requested or flyers are added the NCCC database; these updates assist with timely website maintenance.
- Only eight of the sixteen Michigan Region clubs are currently listed on the NCCC “Find a Club Near You” map. Clubs can add their information by logging into the NCCC Membership Database and selecting Update Club Information. Meeting details should be entered in the Meeting Time section.

Regional Membership – Jennifer Wiegers

- Currently 1019 Michigan Region members (including 24 Members at Large)

- 2 of the MALs have joined clubs
- Largest clubs:
 1. America's Corvette Club – 162 members
 2. Kalamazoo Corvette Club – 156 members
 3. Corvette Club of Michigan – 121 members
- Member cards mailed February 10
- Governors should have gotten the NCCC member only area password
- Governors are encouraged to ensure clubs are listed in NCCC database
- Discussion of two proposed NCCC bylaw changes:
 1. Region minimum membership requirements and probation/merger structure
 2. Removal of 51% NCCC membership requirement within clubs
- Discussion included insurance implications and membership retention concerns
- Feedback from Governors will be taken to National meetings in St. Louis

Regional Competition – Scott Kennedy

- Rookie Driving School moved to Sunday due to a date conflict with Eaton Corp.
- Angela Hanlin requested for the Rookie Driving School be waived of paying the rental fee on the timing equipment. Kyle Felts made a Motion that Rookie Driving School be able to use the timing equipment without rental fees. A second was made by Doug Blower. Voted: Motion **PASSED**
- 2026 Rulebook published and is live
- Approximately 30-40 clarifications from 2024-2025 were incorporated into the rulebook
- Four rule changes and 15 clarifications to be reviewed at the upcoming Competition Committee meeting
- 2026 Speed Event Class Reclassification now in effect
- Hosting clubs are encouraged to review classification changes carefully
- Race America timing system has resumed operations under new ownership
- Discussion of potential live timing technology
- Supplemental Competition Programs:
 - Competitors will need to qualify prior to convention
 - Must Pre-register in advance to participate at convention events
 1. FCOA (ages 9-16)
 2. Young Guns (ages 16-21)
 3. Zora Program
- Please be mindful when scheduling your events so the Supplemental Competition Programs can be supported
- Clarification regarding group classification updates for C2/C3 vehicles

Regional Executive – Kathy Duncan

- National Convention (June 20-27) in Syracuse, NY – registration is now open. Reminder that a full week registration is required for participation in competition events
- Updated contact list of Governors and Comp Reps was distributed; corrections noted

- Reminder to use the official sanction fee worksheet and include it when paying sanction fees to Beth Waters, Region Treasurer
- Send a separate check when paying for timing equipment rental
