Regional Membership – Jennifer Wiegers

- We currently have 16 clubs in our Michigan Region
 - 1,040 members overall including 24 MAL members.
 - We have gained 22 new members since February.
 - Congratulations to the following clubs on welcoming new members since February
 - Lakeshore Corvette Club – 2 new members
 - Westshore Corvettes – 3 new members
 - Corvette Club of Michigan – 4 new members
 - Kalamazoo Corvette Club – 4 new members
 - America's Corvette Club of Michigan – 9 new members
 - Largest 3 clubs in the region:
 - America's Corvette Club with 169 NCCC Members
 - Kalamazoo Corvette Club with 160 NCCC Members

- Corvette Club of Michigan with 126 NCCC Members
- I have had a couple clubs reach out asking for ideas on how to grow their club membership numbers. My best advice is always to be visible. Decide the vibe of your club and get out and about within your community and beyond and spread that vibe and your Corvette love. Be approachable and always have information about your club available for those who may ask. Another way is to make sure your information is on the Find A Club page on NCCC. We only have 8 of our 16 MI Region clubs listed there. If you are not sure how to get your club listed there, please see me tonight after the meeting and I will help you. I have my laptop here and it will take less than 2 minutes to get your club listed there. And last but not least – USE YOUR 14 SANCTIONS and host events!! This is a great way to draw visibility to your club as well. Share the flyers on social media and ask your members to do the same. If you need help on how to host sanctioned events, your first stop should be our RCD, Scott Kennedy, but there are all sorts of people sitting right here in this room that would be more than willing to help you as well with ideas and tips. Car Shows, Rallyes, Funkhanas, Autocross – these are all ways to keep your club visible!
- REMINDERS:
 - All new member applications must reach me within 30 days of signing. This has been a big problem as of lately. Every club is organized differently with how things flow from person to person, but it is your responsibility as Governor to see to it that you are getting information in a timely manner. You owe it to your new members to get them plugged in right away and started off on the right foot. Please let me know if I can be of any assistance to you at all throughout the process or help within your club with ideas on how to organize the flow of the information. I am willing to help wherever you need with that process.
 - Please make sure you are doing a search before adding any member. You can search by name, NCCC number or email. If you run into any issues adding a new member, please reach out to me. There have definitely been some glitches recently and we can deal with them in real time and get the numbers sorted out before you submit.
 - I highly encourage you to get the spouses/companions signed up as well. It is only an extra \$15 for that spouse/companion membership and it gets them the insurance coverage at events whether they are a participant or a worker.
 - Please make sure you are linking spouses/companions to the primary member.
 - Please make sure you are adding FULL address and additional 4-number zip code. This 4-number zip code is directly related to the mailing of blue bars and membership cards and is required as part of the postal rate we receive. We will

be working on this in coming months and I will be reaching out with your members who are missing 4-digit zip in the database.

- If you have a new member attend a sanctioned event, please know they must be in the database prior to the event starting to be covered by insurance. Please call me or text me and I will help you on the spot make this happen. If you have someone that approaches you at an event about becoming a MAL – same thing applies. Call me or text me and I will get them in the database and approved for you so they are covered. If I am at your club's event and either of the above happen, please come find me. Same thing applies – we will get them in the database before the start of the event. I am rarely out and about without my laptop these days.
- All membership cards have been mailed and should have been received by now by all members. We have a few membership cards that were returned with bad mailing addresses. I will be reaching out to those Gov's and asking for address information to be updated in the database so we can get cards out to them. If you are made aware of any members who did not receive membership cards, please let me know so I can coordinate getting those for them.

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Regional Competition – Scott Kennedy – absent, emailed report

 - Please make sure that you reference these helpful documents when planning and executing your events
 - I referenced these in my latest competition newsletter. If you need any help, please ask!
 - I will make every effort to send to event chairs and club Governor's prior to your event.
- Rulebook:
 - It's important to review the rulebook as you are preparing to host events. This book is updated ANNUALLY and there were quite a few changes this last cycle.
 - Take the time to read the updates and meeting minutes that we send out after the national RCD meetings to stay informed of changes.
 - Early season lesson learned: Funkhanas

- There is now a total of 8 classes for Funkhanas encompassing “Open Top and Closed Top”.
 - You need to be sure that the participants at your event are registering in the correct class!

8.1 Three NCCC Standing Rule Proposals

- The following NCCC Standing Rule proposals were discussed and voted on by a Governor Roll Call vote:
- **SR-2025-001-VI** New Rule: In order to finance National competition awards, starting January 1, 2027 clubs holding national sanctioned events will be assessed \$0.25 per participant per sanction. Governor roll call vote: **6 yes; 7 no; 3 abstained/absent**
- **SR-2025-015-VI** Starting January 1, 2027. People may apply for new Member at Large (MAL) membership or renew their existing MAL membership online and pay with a credit card. Dues will follow the dues table in Paragraph 9. A processing fee for the credit card payment will be set at the beginning of the calendar year by the national Treasurer and will be posted on the online application prior to payment fulfillment. Governor roll call vote: **10 yes; 2 no; 4 abstained/absent**

- **SR-2026-004-V3** If you are a First Time Corvette Owner and purchased from a 2nd Tier Corvette Dealer, you may join NCCC as a Member at Large. The Standard Membership Fee is at the Reduced Rate of \$25.00 for Primary and \$10.00 for the Companion Membership fee. At the standard NCCC Membership renewal time standard membership fees will apply. Governor roll call vote: **6 yes; 6 no; 4 abstained/absent**
